ISED Proposed Changes to Tower Policy

In June, Canada's radio regulator, Innovation, Science and Development Canada (ISED), released a consultation on their proposals for changes to their policy on antennas and towers. These proposals will speed up and make easier the processes required to get permission to erect antenna systems. The changes were designed to make things easier for commercial telecommunications providers, but they offer many improvements to Radio Amateurs. For full details, check out the RAC news release:
